- The school year begins on **September 1/14, 2023**, with Divine Liturgy in the morning to celebrate the Ecclesiastical New Year (according to the Julian Calendar). The school year concludes no later than **May 25/June 4, 2024**.
- Please note that our **Microschooling, On-Line, and Blended Learning** programs are designed for **homeschooling families** whose students have access to 3 to 4 hours of at-home learning support each weekday that we do not meet in person. Please, also, note that beginning in Junior Kindergarten, students enrolled in these programs must purchase their curriculum materials (workbooks and other curriculum resources) directly from Memoria Press. **Parents of enrolled students can use our 10% off discount code to save on the cost of these materials.**
- Consumable curriculum materials are included in the tuition for students enrolled in the **Full-Time program**.
- For our On-Line program, parents are asked to be near their Kindergarten to Second Grade students during class time, so as to assist with **technology use**, redirecting **students' attention**, and directing students to the **workbooks needed** during exercises with the instructor.
- Parents are **welcomed and encouraged** to be with their children during class time for our **Microschooling programs**, so as to facilitate and enrich their children's learning experiences. If parents take advantage of this opportunity, we ask that they do not engage in extended and/or off-topic conversations during class time (with other parents and/or with instructors), so as to facilitate **students' focus** and **maximize students' learning**.
